Common federal employers include the following interprovincial and international industries:

- banks
- railways, highway and air transport
- ferries, tunnels, bridges and canals
- telephone and telegraph systems
- pipelines
- radio and television broadcasting and cable systems
- shipping and shipping services
- employment in the operation of ships, trains and aircraft
- licensed grain elevators, and certain feed mills and feed warehouses, flour mills and grain seed clearing plants
- federal public service and persons employed by the public service and Crown corporations and agencies
- Indian reserves
- exploration and development of petroleum on lands subject to federal jurisdiction
